


SELF-GUIDED TOUR MAP



1 'Boys' by Phillip Perides

'Boys' reflects the playful activities of children. Their creativity goes unseen by those around them. This sculpture depicts two boys playing around the water, expressing youth and energy.

With an eye to the elegance of line and form, a slight bend in the metal of these three contemporary boats, give the impression of the wind playing fancifully with the sails.
